Forum Thursday Nov 5th: Joonki Song, PHOTON Consulting

For our November Forum, we are delighted to have an expert to speak on the solar industry: Joonki Song, from [PHOTON Consulting](#). Joonki will discuss the worldwide PV industry: market size, growth, and leaders, as well as the future possibilities for technologies, manufacturing and installed cost.

Joonki Song has a background in corporate finance in the electronics and semiconductor industry, having worked as a financial analyst at Samsung Electronics in Korea. At PHOTON Consulting he leads their research analyzing and forecasting costs and pricing in the mid-stream of the solar PV industry. He also analyses key industries connected to the solar PV sector; his research includes detailed benchmarking of company performance.

Most recently, Mr. Song was an invited panelist at PHOTON's Seventh International Annual Silicon Conference, held this March in Munich, speaking to the topic: *Insight on Costs and Prices and Factory Planning*.
